2022 Nonprofit Executive Coaching Program

What is executive coaching?

According to Stanford Graduate School of Business, executive coaching is an inquiry-based approach to personal and professional development that is aimed at creating awareness, generating action, and facilitating learning and growth. It focuses on improving performance by helping individuals to develop and sustain new perspectives, attitudes, skills and behaviors.

What is this program?

The program will include up to 6 participants from the Greater Lafayette community. The cohort, which will be 9 months long, includes 5 roundtables led by coaches regarding important topics facing nonprofit leaders. A survey from participants will inform the priority of content for the roundtables and may include emotional intelligence, dynamic communication, time management, or problem-solving. The program also matches each cohort member with their own certified professional coach for 9 one-on-one coaching sessions. Coaching sessions will allow for a deeper dive on issues and topics relative to each participant's strengths and needs. Participants will also take leadership and life satisfaction assessments at the beginning and end of the program to measure growth.

Who is the best fit for this program?

Executive Directors within nonprofit organizations with 501(c)3 designation serving the Greater Lafayette area. Preference will be given to emerging leaders, but seasoned leaders and other high level leaders within organizations are still encouraged to apply.
