What is executive coaching?

According to Stanford Graduate School of Business, executive coaching is an inquiry-based approach to personal and professional development that is aimed at creating awareness, generating action, and facilitating learning and growth. It focuses on improving performance by helping individuals to develop and sustain new perspectives, attitudes, skills and behaviors.

What is this program?

The program will include up to 6 participants from the Greater Lafayette community. The cohort, which will be 9 months long, includes 5 roundtables led by coaches regarding important topics such as emotional intelligence, dynamic communication, time management, or problem-solving, facing nonprofit leaders. The program also includes 9 one on one coaching sessions. Each participant will work with a certified coach on issues and topics relative to their strengths and needs. Participants will also take leadership and life satisfaction assessments at the beginning of the program and assessments at the end of the program to measure growth. If selected, participants will receive all coaching at no cost.

Who is the best fit for this program?

Executive Directors or high-level leaders within nonprofit organizations with 501(c)3 designation serving the Greater Lafayette area. Preference will be given to emerging leaders, but seasoned leaders are still encouraged to apply, as coaching benefits even the most experienced and successful executives.
